Summer Enrichment

Summer Enrichment is a summer program for students who have finished kindergarten through sixth grade. We welcome students from all schools!

Summer Enrichment is held in Vest Hall on the campus of Columbia Academy.

The cost is \$80 per week. A \$30 deposit must accompany your application, regardless of the number of weeks your child is attending. This will reserve your child a spot and your child will receive a Summer Enrichment T-shirt. A deposit is not required if your child is only attending camp. Payment is expected the Monday of every week your child attends.

Our hours are 7:00 a.m. - 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. A \$5 late fee will be charged for every 15 minutes a child is late being picked-up. "Drop-in" fee is \$30 per day.

Students will provide their own lunch and two snacks. A refrigerator and microwave are available for use.

A few of the activities that your child will be involved in this summer include: arts and crafts, Bible study, movies (G-rated), skating, local parks, water days, and learning centers. Children will be grouped by ages for organized activities.
